Abbreviated Prescribing information for **DROXYL DT 125 TABLET** [Cefadroxil 125 mg Disintegrating Tablet] [Please refer the complete prescribing information available at www.torrentpharma.com]

PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES: Beta-lactam antibiotics, cephalosporins which inhibits bacterial wall synthesis of actively dividing cells by binding to one or more penicillin-binding proteins.

INDICATION: Urinary tract infections, skin structure infections caused by *Staphylococci* or *Streptococci*, pharyngitis, tonsillitis, respiratory tract infections in children only.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION: As per the physician direction.

CONTRAINDICATION: Hypersensitivity to any of the components of product or to cephalosporin group antibiotics.

WARNINGS & PRECAUTIONS: Previous hypersensitivity to cephalosporin, or penicillins; creatinine clearance less than 50ml/min; Prolong use may result in overgrowth of nonsusceptible organism; Colitis; False positive laboratory tests (i.e. positive comb's test) reported.

DRUG INTERACTIONS: It is having interaction with bacteriostatic antibiotics like tetracycline, erythromycin, sulfonamides, chloramphenicol; also nephrotoxic agents like aminoglycoside antibiotics, polymyxin B, colistin or high-dose loop diuretics; anticoagulants or thrombocyte aggregation inhibitors (long term use); probenecid; oral contraceptives; cholestyramine; false positive glycosuria tests.

ADVERSE REACTIONS: Hyper sensitivity reactions (Pruritus, rash, allergic exanthema, urticarial, angioneurotic oedema, drug fever, serum sickness-like reactions, arthralgia, interstitial nephritis, Immediate allergic reaction, SJS, erythema multiforme), eosinophilia, thrombocytopenia, leucopenia, neutropenia, agranulocytosis, haemolytic anaemia, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, dyspepsia, abdominal pain, glossitis, pseudomembranous colitis, *C. Difficile* diarrhea, elevation of serum transaminases, ALP, cholestase, idiosyncratic hepatic failure, headache, dizziness, nervousness, sleeplessness, fatigue, vaginal mycoses, thrush, colitis.
