**PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES:** Levocarnitine is a naturally occurring substance required in mammalian energy metabolism. It has been shown to facilitate long-chain fatty acid entry into cellular mitochondria, therefore delivering substrate for oxidation & subsequent energy production.

**INDICATION:** CARNISURE™ Injection is indicated in the treatment of secondary carnitine deficiency e.g. in haemodialysis patients.

**DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:** CARNISURE™ Injection is administered intravenously. The recommended dose is 20-40 mg/kg given as a slow 2-3 minute bolus injection or by infusion.

**CONTRAINDICATION:** Not known.

**WARNINGS & PRECAUTIONS:** High dose not recommended in patients with severely renal compromised patient/ESRD patients.

**DRUG INTERACTIONS:** None known.

**ADVERSE REACTIONS:** Various mild gastrointestinal complaints have been reported during the long-term administration of oral levocarnitine, these include transient nausea, vomiting, abdominal cramps and diarrhoea.
