Abbreviated Prescribing information for XTPARA SUSPENSION (Paracetamol Paediatric Oral Suspension I.P.)

PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES: Paracetamol produces analgesic and antipyretic as main effects and it has been also reported that paracetamol has a weak anti-inflammatory effect. Analgesic action: The central analgesic action of Paracetamol resembles that of aspirin. It produces analgesia by raising pain threshold. Antipyretic effect: The antipyretic effect of Paracetamol is attributed to its ability to inhibit COX in the brain where peroxide tone is low. Recent evidence suggests inhibition of COX-3 (believed to be splice variant product of the COX-1 gene) could represent a primary central mechanism by which Paracetamol decreases pain and possibly fever. Paracetamol is a peripherally acting analgesic with antipyretic activity.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

For paediatric use only.

Directions for use: 3-4 times a day or as directed by the physician.

Method of administration

XTPARA SUSPENSION is for Oral use only.

CONTRAINDICATION: Hypersensitivity to paracetamol or any of the other constituents.

WARNINGS & PRECAUTIONS: Care is advised in the administration of Paracetamol to patients with severe renal or severe hepatic impairment. The hazards of overdose are greater in those with (non-cirrhotic) alcoholic liver disease.

DRUG INTERACTION: The anticoagulant effect of warfarin and other coumarins may be enhanced by prolonged regular daily use of paracetamol with increased risk of bleeding; occasional doses have no significant effect.

ADVERSE REACTIONS: Hypersensitivity, Thrombocytopenia, Agranulocytosis, Hepatic necrosis, Acute pancreatitis and Nephrotoxicity.
