### PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES:

**MECHANISM OF ACTION:** After exposure to skin damaging factors (environmental factors, dermatological procedures, etc.), skin needs special care. While we can't undo the damage but we can accelerate the repair with skin repair gel. Skin repair gel is crucial for rehydrating damage skin. It also helps to repair our skin by cooling it down and locking in lost moisture. Benefits Of Using Ahaglow Skin Repair Gel: Lightweight gel that gets easily absorbed, Formulated with soothing botanical extracts (Lotus, Kiwi, Aloe vera ), Reduces the number of sunburn cells (Ectoin- Literature based), Hydrates and replenishes the skin (Marine based moisturizing active), Lightens skin tone (Marine based skin lightening active), Acts as an Anti-oxidant, It is Non comedogenic

**INDICATIONS:** Ahaglow skin repair gel is a repair formula designed to restore the integrity and barrier function of skin. Helps skin overcome the symptoms of skin damage (redness, tanning, burning and dehydration). Beneficial for superficial skin remodelling post dermatological procedures.

**DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:** Take adequate amount of gel and gently apply on the affected area as directed by physician.

**CONTRAINDICATION:** Hypersensitivity to any cosmetic product, raw material, Discontinue use, if signs of irritation or rash appear. Avoid contact with eyes, rinse with water immediately in case of accidental contact. Do not swallow.

**WARNINGS & PRECAUTIONS:** Factors Contributing to Skin Damage: Solar radiations, Pollutants, Weather, Laser treatments, Stress and Smoking; Skin conditions like Acne /dermatitis / rosacea; Hormonal dysfunction, Medication side effects. Avoid usage during pregnancy and breast-feeding. Oral aloe is not recommended during pregnancy due to theoretical stimulation of uterine contractions, and in breastfeeding mothers, it may sometime cause gastrointestinal distress in the nursing infant.

**DRUG INTERACTIONS:** If your doctor has directed you to use this product, or if you use any prescription product on the skin, tell your doctor or pharmacist of all prescription and non-prescription/herbal products you may use, including other skin care products. Aloe Barbadensis Leaf Juice Application of aloe to skin may increase the absorption of steroid creams such as hydrocortisone. It reduces the effectiveness and may increase the adverse effects of digoxin and digitoxin, due to its potassium lowering effect. Combined use of Aloe vera and furosemide may increase the risk of potassium depletion. It decreases the blood sugar levels and thus may interact with oral hypoglycaemic drugs and insulin.
