PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES: It is a lipophilic derivative of Thiorphan. It is Enkephalinase inhibitor.

INDICATION: Treatment of acute diarrhoea.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION: The recommended dose of racecadotril is one capsule immediately and one capsule three times a day up to 5 days or up to two normal stools are recorded. Treatment should not exceed 7 days.

CONTRAINDICATION: Zedott is contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to the ingredients of the formulation.

WARNINGS & PRECAUTIONS: Renal/hepatic insufficiency as no data available. Pregnant woman and lactating mothers.

ADVERSE REACTIONS: Dizziness, malaise, headache, persistence of hypokalemia (especially in children), GI adverse events, abdominal distention, vomiting, rash, erythematous/papulous reaction, prurigo or urticaria, multiform erythema, erythema nodosum, and lip or tongue oedema, angioneurotic oedema.
