PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES: Calcium is a mineral that is present naturally in the food. Cholecalciferol is the naturally occurring form of Vitamin D3.

INDICATION: In calcium deficiency, supplementation of calcium during growth, pregnancy, lactation or as recommended by the Physician.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION: As directed by the physician.

CONTRAINDICATION: Shelcal contraindicated to patients with hypercalcaemia and hypercalciuria, nephrolithiasis, nephrocalciosis, renal failure, hypervitaminosis D and hypersensitivity to calcium or to any of the excipients.

WARNINGS & PRECAUTIONS: Patients with mild to moderate renal failure or mild hypercalciuria should be supervised carefully, also in patients with a history of renal stones urinary calcium excretion should be measured to exclude hypercalciuria, also caution is required in patients receiving treatment for cardiovascular disease. Prescribed with caution to patient of sarcoidosis, immobilised patients with osteoporosis, hypercalcaemia and suffering from malignancies.

DRUG INTERACTIONS: Thiazide diuretics drugs can reduce urinary calcium excretion, if taken concomitantly. It can interact with corticosteroids, cholestyramine or laxatives, Calcium carbonate, tetracycline, cardiac glycosides, bisphosphonate or sodium fluoride, Rifampicin, phenytoin or barbiturates, estramustin or thyroid hormones, Oxalic acid and phytic acid.

ADVERSE REACTIONS: Hypercalcaemia, abdominal pain, flatulence, nausea constipations, tachycardia, diarrhea, palpitation, hypercalciuria, Pruritus, rash and urticaria.
