PHARMACOLOGICAL PROPERTIES: Mecobalamin is one of the two active coenzyme forms of vitamin B_{12} . Alpha-lipoic acid is a disulfide compound that is a cofactor in vital energy producing reactions in the body. It is also known as thioctic acid. Folic acid is known as pteroylmonoglutamic acid. Pyridoxine hydrochloride is the principle form of vitamin B_6 used in nutritional supplements.

INDICATION: For the treatment of diabetic neuropathy.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION: One capsule of Cobasoft OD to be taken daily.

CONTRAINDICATION: Cobasoft OD is contraindicated in patients who are sensitive to any of the ingredients in this medicine.

WARNINGS & PRECAUTIONS: The use of Cobasoft OD to treat any medical condition requires medical supervision. It should not be used for long time, in case of lack of satisfactory clinical response in patients with diabetic neuropathies. It should be avoided in pregnant women and nursing mothers. As alpha lipoic acid may lower blood glucose levels, patients with diabetes and problems with glucose intolerance should be cautious. The patients taking levodopa without carbidopa should avoid pyridoxine above dose of 5mg per day.

ADVERSE REACTIONS: Constituents in Cobasoft OD are generally well tolerated.
